

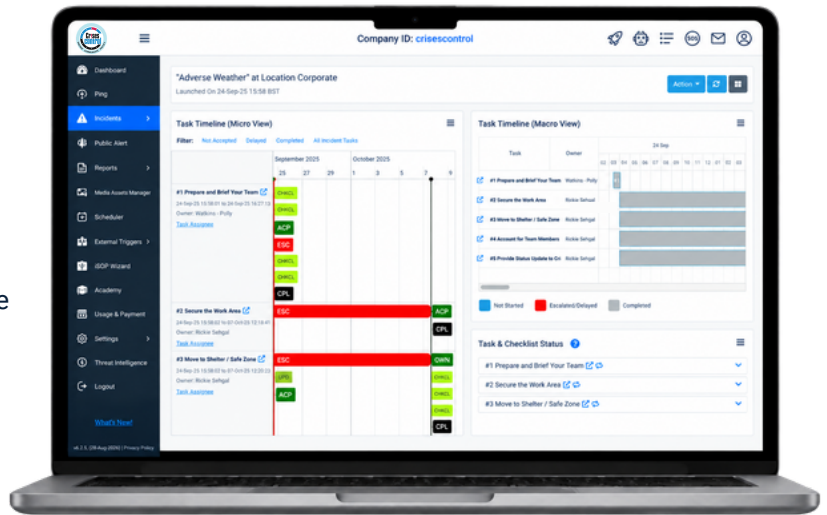


INCIDENT TASK MANAGER

KEEP EVERY CRITICAL RESPONSE TASK VISIBLE AND ON TRACK.

Crises Control Task Manager turns incident response plans into assigned, tracked and completed actions.

Give every critical task a clear owner, monitor progress in real time, automate escalations and maintain accountability throughout the incident.



Clear Task Ownership

Assign response tasks to the right people or teams, with clear responsibility for every action.



Real-Time Task Tracking

Monitor task status, deadlines and completion progress as the incident unfolds.



Automated Escalation

Automatically escalate overdue or unclaimed tasks based on configurable rules.



Workflow Dependencies

Set task dependencies so actions follow the correct response sequence.



Task Reassignment

Reassign tasks when circumstances change or an owner is unavailable.



Complete Accountability

Record task ownership, acceptance, status changes, escalations and completion activity as part of the incident record.

- ✓ **Assign Tasks**
Send actions directly to named owners or teams.
- ✓ **Set Deadlines**
Give every action a clear completion requirement.
- ✓ **Monitor Progress**
See what is completed, in progress, overdue or unclaimed.
- ✓ **Automate Workflows**
Use dependencies and rules to keep response actions moving.
- ✓ **Escalate Automatically**
Notify supervisors, reassign tasks or escalate when required.
- ✓ **Maintain the Record**
Capture task activity for post-incident review, governance and audit.

HOW IT WORKS



ASSIGNED

Task is assigned to a person or team.



ACCEPTED

Owner accepts the task and takes responsibility.



IN PROGRESS

Work begins and progress is tracked in real time.



COMPLETED

Task is completed and recorded.



OVERDUE OR UNCLAIMED

Task is escalated or reassigned



ESCALATE

Notify the appropriate supervisor when a task is overdue or requires intervention.



REASSIGN

Transfer the task to another owner when circumstances change or the original owner is unavailable.
